Updated: April 27, 2021



Orange County recently moved into the less-restrictive orange tier and further opened eligibility to receive the COVID-19 vaccine to everyone ages 16 and up. As your trusted health care partner, we want to ensure that you have the information you need to safely return to an active life – which should first include obtaining your COVID-19 vaccine when eligible.
