

Recruiting Healthy Volunteers for a COVID-19 Vaccine Research Study

STUDY TITLE: Phase 1b Open-Label Study of the Safety, Reactogenicity, and Immunogenicity of Subcutaneously and Orally Administered Prophylactic Vaccination with 2nd Generation E1/E2b/E3-Deleted Adenoviral Covid-19 in Normal Healthy Volunteers

You may qualify if you meet these criteria:

- Healthy adults, ages 18 to 55 years, inclusive at time of enrollment
- Negative for COVID-19 infection and no known previous COVID-19 exposure or disease
- Agree to the collection of a nasopharyngeal swab and have blood collected
- No known infection with human immunodeficiency virus (HIV), hepatitis C (HCV)virus, hepatitis B virus (HBV) and immunocompromised individuals with known or suspected immunodeficiency, as determined by history and/or laboratory examination.
- No Bleeding conditions
- No Pregnant or breastfeeding women
- No history of any severe vaccine reaction and no history of a previous vaccination for coronavirus
- Taking medications intended to prevent COVID-19
- Able to understand and provide a signed informed consent

Participation involves:

- Ability to attend all required study visits over a 1-year period
- Completion of a vaccine-specific daily diary
- Receive the investigational vaccine or placebo

Potential benefits:

If you agree to take part in this study, there may or may not be a direct medical benefit to you. The information collected during this study may help the Sponsor, Study Doctors, Hoag Memorial Hospital Presbyterian and researchers learn more about COVID-19 and the study vaccine that may benefit you and other participants.
